The National Greenhouse Energy Reporting Act 2007 requires organisations and facilities whose energy production, energy use or greenhouse gas emissions meets certain thresholds, to submit comprehensive auditable reports back to the Department of Climate Change.

BGC Contracting Pty Ltd, one of Australia's leading Mining and Civil Construction contractors, is committed to meeting its environmental responsibilities and BGC Contracting's Charter and Policies encapsulate the protection of the environment. While BGC has been participating in the Greenhouse Gas Challenge program with the Australian Government since October 2006, they are required to report their emissions information to the Dept of Climate change under the National Energy Reporting Act 2007 for the first time this year.



The biggest challenges organisations have been facing under the new legislation is how they will manage to capture the data associated with

their emissions and then transform that information into emissions factors – like converting electricity consumption into tonnes of CO2 emitted. Operational boundaries were also proving tricky – for example: when can a facilities manager relinquish responsibility for emissions generated by a tenant? Even organisations like BGC Contracting, who have been voluntarily participating in schemes requiring this data, were finding that manually managing this information in spreadsheets was resulting in misinformation, was resource intensive as well as expensive. BGC Contracting's CIO, Brenton Corbett recognised very early on that this was not a long term solution.

After considerable research BGC had almost settled on building a solution internally to meet their needs, then after considering the effort for modifications, reporting and keeping up to date with legislation requirements now and in the future, the Ndevr solution rapidly became a very cost effective solution.
